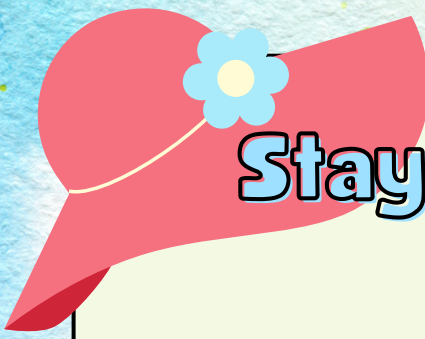

Summer Reminder: Keep Records Current

Summer can bring schedule changes, vacations, and busy days, but it's still important to keep your CACFP records updated daily.

Please remember to:

- Record attendance daily
- Centers must record meal counts during the point of service
- Homes must record meal counts by the end of each day
- Update KidKare menus when substitutions are made
- Keep your Food Program Binder organized and current

Staying caught up throughout the month helps make reviews and claim processing much smoother.

Enrollment Form Reminder

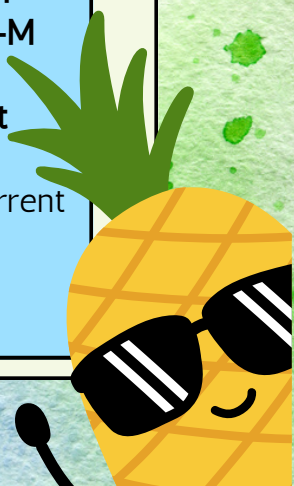
Please take time this month to review your enrollment forms and make sure everything is complete and up to date.

A few helpful reminders:

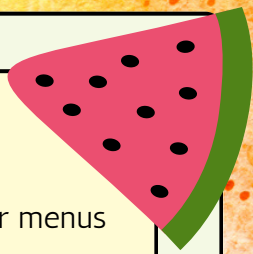
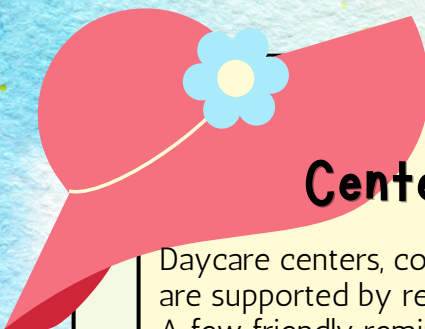
- Use the current version of the enrollment form
- Make sure all forms are fully completed
- Ensure forms are signed and dated properly
- Do not use white out on forms
- Any corrections should be lined through, initialed, and dated

Daycare home providers with last names beginning with A–M should also be working on renewing enrollment forms at this time.

Keeping enrollment forms current helps avoid delays and compliance findings during reviews.

Centers: Receipt & Menu Reminders

Daycare centers, continue making sure that all food items listed on your menus are supported by receipts.

A few friendly reminders:

- KidKare menus should reflect exactly what was served
- Menu changes and substitutions must be reflected on the posted menu and updated in KidKare
- CACFP receipts should be kept separate from personal purchases
- Receipts should be itemized and easy to read

Keeping your menus and receipts organized throughout the month helps make claim processing and reviews much smoother.

Summer Organization Reset

Summer is a great time to refresh and organize your CACFP records.

Take a few moments to:

- Organize your Food Program Binder
- Review your Menu Documentation Binder
- Make sure training certificates are filed properly
- Review enrollment forms for completeness
- Centers should double check that receipts are organized by month
- Review standardized recipes and CN labels

Staying organized throughout the year can help make claim processing and compliance reviews much easier.

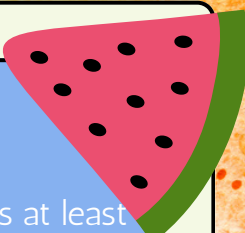
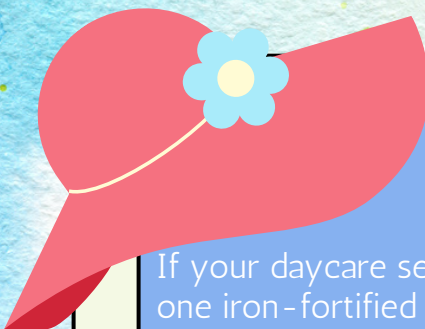
Monthly Claim Reminder

Claims are due by the **2nd** of each month according to your Permanent Agreement.

To help make the process easier, a monthly Claim Checklist is emailed on the last day of each month outlining the required documentation needed to process your claim.

Submitting complete and organized claims helps avoid delays in processing and reimbursement.



Infant Formula Reminder

If your daycare serves infants, you are required to have at all times at least one iron-fortified infant formula that is creditable under CACFP. This formula must be offered to enrolled infants. Make sure an Infant Statement is on file for all enrolled infants.

Providers are reminded that exempt infant formulas require a completed medical statement in order to be claimed under CACFP.

Menu Documentation Reminder

Make sure your Menu Documentation Binder stays organized and current throughout the summer months.

Remember to keep:

- Standardized recipes for homemade combination foods
- Current CN labels and Product Formulation Statements (PFS) for commercially prepared main dish food items
- Updated menu records
- Whole grain labels

Commercially prepared main dish items such as chicken nuggets, pizza, corn dogs, fish sticks, burritos, and similar products must have a valid CN label or Product Formulation Statement on file to document how the item credits toward the CACFP meal pattern requirements.

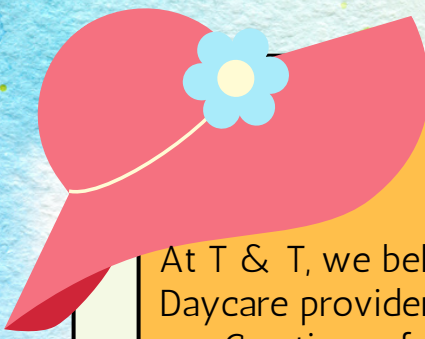
Having complete menu documentation readily available helps support your menus during reviews.
